



Cashmere Hooded Scarf

A knitting pattern by Staci Perry, www.verypink.com



Finished Measurements: scarf length = 65", scarf width = 7"

Needles: Size US 13 circulars or straights

Yarn: 3 hanks of Yarn Harvest Cashmere

Additional Materials: tapestry needle, tape measure

Gauge: 11 stitches over 4"

Abbreviations:

BO – bind-off

CO – cast-on

K – knit

P – purl

Directions:

CO 20 stitches, and knit every row until piece measures 23" from CO row.

HOOD

Using backwards-loop method, CO an additional 30 stitches at the end of the next row.

Work across these 50 stitches for 17".

BO the 30 hood stitches, leaving you with your initial 20 stitches. Knit every row for 23", and BO.

FINISHING

Fold the piece in half, and seam the top of the hood stitches together. Weave in ends, and steam block to finish.

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
